**Program Policies:** All applicants will be considered individually by the DNP Admission Committee. Once admitted, students must maintain an unencumbered WV RN license and a 3.0 GPA for all graduate work. Students will be admitted as a cohort group for Fall; admission is competitive to the program. Each applicant will:

- Be a graduate of an accredited B.S.N. (and when applicable, MSN) program.
- Have a minimum 3.0 undergraduate (and when applicable, graduate) grade point on all previous college work. •
- Complete the WVWC Graduate Studies Admission Application.
- Provide a 300 500 word statement regarding a topic of interest for a DNP project. ●
- Submit official undergraduate (and when applicable, graduate)
   transcript(s) and current vita/resume.
- Submit three letters of professional reference, one of which is from a current supervisor or faculty member (employment or school-related).
- Submit validation of an unencumbered license to practice.
- Be interviewed by West Virginia Wesleyan College and Shenandoah University, if applicable.
- Demonstrate proficiency in English if a non-native English speaker by submitting scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
