



ACCELERATED RN TO MSN PROGRAM

West Virginia Wesleyan College offers a flexible, accelerated pathway, the RN to MSN, designed for the working professional with rolling admission which prepares students for certification exam or MSN in leadership.



THE PROGRAM

- Designed for working nurses or professionals in the field
- Students first complete 20 credit hours (three semesters) of bridge coursework, then proceed to seven semesters of graduate level work.
- The coursework is delivered through online, asynchronous formats, with four classes having a hybrid model of one to two days per semester on campus.

- Admission is competitive to the program. Following completion of the program, students may sit for the National Certification Examination in their chosen field.
