REMINDERS

1. Accounting majors should begin their accounting courses in their freshman year! Students who are not 100-level math placed should enroll in DEVL-070, Developmental Algebra or MATH-101, Intermediate Algebra in the fall semester of the freshman year.
2. Do not take more than one three-hour business elective.
3. Remind students that they may want to save their business elective for an internship experience.
4. Only six hours of any minor may overlap with the required credit hours of a student's chosen major. The overlap constraint is not applicable to courses that majors or minors MUST take in others departments.
