WV PROMISE **\$5,500**

WESLEYAN SERVICE SCHOLARS **\$3,000**

Scholarships are awarded based on strong community service and leadership involvement.

A separate application must be completed by February 1. Contact wvwcservice@wvwc.edu.

CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS **\$1000-\$7000**

Awards are available for music, theatre, technical theatre, musical theatre, dance, art, and writing.

A private or weekend audition/portfolio review is required. Contact TheArts@wvwc.edu to schedule.

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS **\$500-TUITION**

Accepted student athletes must meet NCAA Division II requirements and register with the Eligibility Center. Visit WesleyanBobcats.com to contact a coach and schedule a visit.

General Scholarships: WVWC has over 600 endowed scholarships available to new students! They range in size and are awarded based on a student's FAFSA, program of study, or other demographic information. These are awarded on official aid packages.

Merit Scholarships: The Presidential, Deans, and Wesleyan Merit awards are awarded at the time of application. No separate application is needed and no ongoing GPA is required. Students must file a FAFSA and stay enrolled full-time in good standing.

FAFSA: Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid as soon as you can. Our code is **003830**. West Virginia Students should also file applications for the WV Promise and WV Higher Education Grant at www.cfww.com.

Combining of Awards: WVWC "stacks" awards, meaning students may combine a merit award (presidential, deans, or WVWC merit) with a talent award, federal awards (like a Pell Grant), WV awards (like a WV Promise or Higher Education Grant), Wesleyan Grants or Scholarships, and outside awards. The only awards that cannot be combined are talent awards with other talent awards (service, arts, athletics).

• All WVWC funded merit, talent, and need-based awards are based on full-time in-person instruction and the total cost for tuition, room, board, and fees. WVWC funded aid does not exceed direct cost. Students must be accepted for admission and file a FAFSA to be eligible for WVWC Aid.
